SPECIAL MEETING OF THE LYON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Lyon County Board of Commissioners will hold a special meeting on Tuesday, January 28, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. in the Law Enforcement Center Basement, 611 W. Main St., Marshall, MN, to take public comment on a request for Lyon County to consent to allow initial refugee resettlement in Lyon County.

On September 26, 2019, President Trump issued an executive order requiring state and local governments to provide written consent to the federal government before refugees can be resettled in their jurisdictions. Beginning June 1, 2020, the order will generally apply to all arriving refugees including those with family members already living in Minnesota. All interested parties are invited to attend. If you are unable to attend, any comments or questions may be submitted in writing by January 27, 2020, to the Lyon County Administrator's Office or by email to: lorenstomberg@ co.lyon.mn.us
