WEED SPRAY NOTICE

The Lyon County Highway Department will be spot spraying roadside ditches for tree, brush and broadleaf weed control this summer and fall. The County will allow adjacent landowners to come into the office to sign up for areas of roadside ditches they do not want sprayed.

Areas requested not to be sprayed will be put on a spray exclusion map. Owners shall then be held responsible for vegetation control. Vegetation control in the right-of-way includes brush, trees, thistle, leafy spurge, and other noxious weeds.

Should the weed inspector notify us or if problem areas are found, the County will spray those areas and bill the property owners accordingly.

Stop in or call to be added to the exclusion map. All areas you wish not to be sprayed must be identified on maps prior to July 29, 2022. Spraying will begin on August 3, 2022.

\$200,000 of ARPA dollars to the City of Balaton to include \$54,000 for the Fire Department and \$146,000 for the water tower project.

MSP to move forward with installing simulcast in Lyon County with a cap of \$260,000 to come from ARPA dollars.
